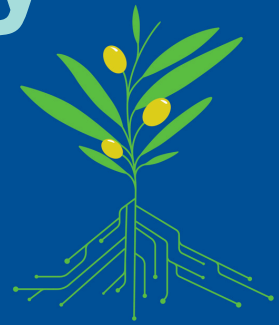

HOW TO CONTRIBUTE

The IASP 2026 World Conference welcomes submissions from everyone—researchers, companies, institutions, and actors from both emerging and mature innovation ecosystems.

What to Submit ?

Each submission must include three required elements:

1 Executive Summary
(maximum
1,700 characters)

2 One-minute Video
(presenting the executive summary,
recorded by the person who would speak at
the conference. Simple recording tools -
Zoom or smartphone)

3 Full Paper
(between 10,500 and 21,000
characters, including
tables/graphs; references)

Important

- **The official language of the Conference is English. All papers and videos must be written and presented in high-standard English.**
- All submissions must be made **exclusively through the online platform** (Word/PDF files are not accepted)
- An automatic email confirms receipt once the submission is effective. If you do not receive it, the submission was not completed.
